You are invited to a public informational meeting to learn about Chagrin River restoration work planned at the City of Willoughby's Daniels Park. The river restoration is part of a larger project to protect and restore Chagrin River corridor at Daniels Park and adjacent lands, funded through a \$2.2 million grant awarded to Chagrin River Watershed Partners from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources through the H2Ohio Initiative. This meeting will be hosted by Chagrin River Watershed Partners, the City of Willoughby, Western Reserve Land Conservancy, the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, and the project's selected design-build restoration team, Biohabitats, Inc. The purpose of this meeting is to engage the public during the design phase of this project. Local residents, park users, anglers, outdoor clubs, agency partners, and other community members will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide input. Topics presented at the public informational meeting will include:

- An overview of the H2Ohio program and specific project goals
- · Benefits for water quality, fish and wildlife habitat, and the community
- Description of the proposed restoration approach
- Updates about the use of Daniels Park during project construction
